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## Introduction

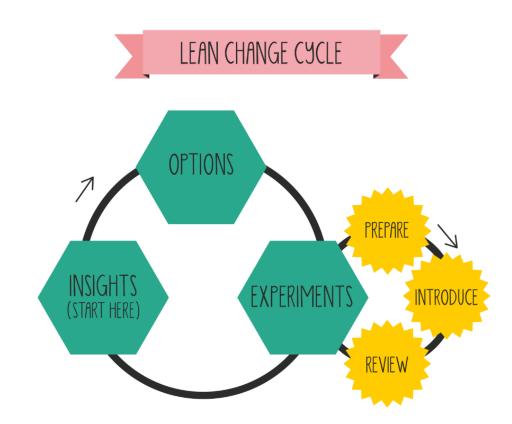
**Agility** is understood as the ability to **create and respond to change to generate customer value** in a constantly changing environment.

- An organisation can lose up to 11.4% of its investment through poor project management and have up to 67% of failed projects.
- Thanks to the implementation of agile methodologies, **cost savings of more than 25% and time savings of 35%** can be achieved.

# **Change agility**

> Change agility is a balance between the **art** (skills, change posture, experiments) and the **science** (mental models, tools, measurements) of change.

> The Lean Change Cycle model implies the need to attend to the people involved, as they are the drivers and prescribers of change.

It seeks the integration of agile principles, values and practices by placing employees and the customer at the centre of every interaction. This is fostered through feedback, lead generation and supporting the retention of internal talent in the organisation:

2. United team and flexibility.

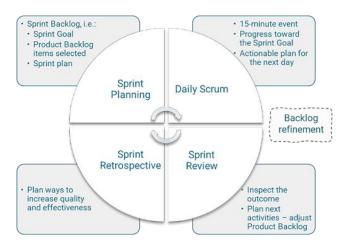
